

That source water from the 'dark depths' has been filtered through the Okanagan Valley, free of pollutants and surface contamination. It is also reflective of Grant Stevely, the artisan distiller, who has shared the name in his family for generations.



Sarah Bain, Winemaker

Sarah joined Fitz in 2016 from Quartz Reef: one of New Zealand's leading producers of traditional method sparkling.

There are a few characteristics that set this special place by Okanagan Lake apart from all the others. The first is that they are physically and literally set apart. South of Peachland, north of Summerland, and if you look in those directions from the winery, you won't see other vineyards. Across the lake is Parkland and Ogopogo's house (seriously). They are sitting in their own nanoclimate in a valley of microclimates. There is no other winery in the Okanagan growing in their specific set of conditions. In wine, we call that terroir, and theirs is distinctly Fitz.

Stag's Hollow Winery was established in 1995 on the property which now grows Merlot, Pinot Noir, Cabernet Franc, Cabernet Sauvignon, Sauvignon Blanc, Tempranillo, Muscat Ottonel and Vidal. These vines are now over 30 years old. In 2011, they purchased an 18-acre hayfield, now called the Shuttleworth Creek Vineyard, and planted Tempranillo and Albariño from Spain, Dolcetto and Teroldego from Italy and more Pinot Noir and Syrah.

Environmentally conscious - using geothermal heating and cooling in the cellar, commercial building and residence in 1995, and then again in a new Winery facility built in 2006. Stag's Hollow Winery and Vineyard practices are sustainable and incorporate organic practices. Stag's Hollow Winery and their two vineyards were certified sustainable through Sustainable Winegrowing BC in early 2022



Keira LeFranc, Winemaker

Keira's winemaking style strives to showcase the terroir and natural attributes of the varietal, and careful attention to vinification, most wines are made with minimal intervention, without fining, and are vegan friendly.

It's only natural.

Birch Block is a family-owned, 5-acre vineyard in Kaleden. Named for the large stand of white Birch trees along the top vineyard block. The unique terroir, with sand and loam as well as glacial deposits, combined with long summer days and cool summer nights, make it an ideal site for Pinot Noir - Murray and Sarah's favorite grape. In 2016 they planted pinot noir vines from Dijon clones (115, 667, 777) on 3.5 acres. The site had never been cultivated; it was originally a pasture for llamas and sheep. They are farming organically and believe in a "less is more" philosophy, employing natural winemaking practices with minimal intervention - a true expression of fruit and terroir.

Meet the Makers

Hailing from Vancouver, husband and wife Murray and Sarah Bancroft come from culinary and media backgrounds, respectively. They have both travelled to France extensively since their early 20s and took their young daughters to Paris for a sabbatical year in 2016–2017. With a long-time interest in wine, Murray has participated in both vendange (harvest) and winemaking in Champagne and Bordeaux, and continues to return every year. While working as an international culinary consultant, he spent evenings and weekends studying viniculture at California's U.C. Davis. Sarah enjoys "researching" wine (especially rosé) with friends and family any day of the week.


It is in appreciation of art and harmony that classical music echoes in the vineyard and cellar where the winemaker captures an accumulation of moments and composes quality wines.

Project 'B' is a David and Goliath collaboration involving winegrower Michael Bartier, co-owner of Bartier Bros., a south Okanagan boutique estate, and acclaimed English négociant/winemaking force, Boutinot Wines.

Boutinot has long been known for making delicious wines at an affordable price. From humble beginnings, the UK wine distributor began investing in winemaking projects worldwide, working with likeminded partners and building an amazing business structure.


The philosophy and business model of partnering with growers in various regions spawned a growing team of winemakers, including their enthusiastic chief winemaker Eric Monnin, based in Burgundy. Initial roots were set down in the Rhone Valley at Carianne. From there, the business and exploration took them to South Africa in 1994. In 2003 they established a joint venture with Araldica, Coop in Piemonte, Italy and, more recently, the company bought a long-time supplier and now produces English sparkling wine at Henner's. Project 'B' is Boutinot's first reach into Canada after distributing its wines across the country.

The Name: 'B' surfaced as a constant in the partnership; a Boutinot – Bartier team, our first harvest from Plot B, and as a special nod to the Boutinot Rhone symbol of quality, the Worker Bee.

Elysia Vineyard

Home to the winery, this vineyard was planted in 2006 with Pinot Noir, Viognier and Syrah. It overlooks Okanagan Lake to the east and enjoys the early and midday sun.

Canyonview Vineyard

Planted in 2003 on the precipice of the Trout Creek Canyon, this south-facing vineyard has sandy soil that is dotted with river stones, producing spectacular Pinot Noir and Chardonnay from two large terraces.

Trestle Beach Vineyard

Affectionately referred to as the "baby plot" this vineyard was planted with Gamay Noir in 2020. It rests on a steep slope adjacent to Canyonview Vineyard in glacial deposits and calcareous-dense soils.

Sébastien Hotte, or Seb for short is a Washington State University graduate, and certified sommelier from the École Hôtelière des Laurentides who believes in low-intervention and terroir-driven winemaking. He has worked in the wine industry for several benchmark wineries, is an acting consultant.




